

Diocesan Awards

The Office of the Superintendent of Schools of the Diocese of Bridgeport hosted a Breakfast of Champions on May 24, 2017, to honor select students in Catholic schools throughout the diocese. Students who are graduating from their schools in Grade 5, Grade 8 or Grade 12 are chosen to receive awards.

Julia Dabrowski was the 2017 recipient of the St. Thomas Aquinas Award from St. Mark School. She was selected for this award because of her academic performance as well as exemplifying the Catholic Faith through community service and Christ-like behavior. The award is named after St. Thomas Aquinas who was outstanding in the practice of virtue and in the area of academics. St. Thomas was one of the greatest and most influential theologians of all time. He was canonized in 1323 and declared Doctor of the Church by Pope Pius V. Congratulations, Julia!



The St. Augustine Medal of Service was instituted in the Diocese of Bridgeport in 2005 to recognize the "unsung heroes" who unselfishly give of their time and talents to build up parish communities. This year diocesan schools were also asked to recognize people who exemplify this spirit in their school communities. A St. Augustine Medal of Service is given to each recipient. On one side of the medal is an image of St. Augustine of Hippo, Patron Saint of the Diocese of Bridgeport. The reverse side features the coat of arms of the diocese.

The St. Augustine Medal prayer service and awards ceremony was held at St. Augustine Cathedral. Bishop Frank J. Caggiano lead the prayer service and presented medals to over 150 recipients from parishes, schools, and ministries across the diocese. St. Mark School nominated Mrs. Christine Feliciano to receive the St. Augustine Medal this year. Mrs. Feliciano has been a St. Mark parent for 10 years. Throughout these years, she has been involved in numerous school activities and committees giving of her time and talent wherever needed such as fundraisers, field day, class trips, and Class Night. She is a faith-filled wife and mother of two who uses the gifts God has given her to help and lend support St. Mark. Congratulations, Mrs. Feliciano!
